Ohio Chemical Dependency Professionals Board

Pursuant to Section 119.032 of the Ohio Revised Code, notice is hereby given that the Ohio Chemical Dependency Professionals (OCDP) Board intends to file the following no change rules as part of its five year rule review:

OAC 4758-1-01 Adoption of rules/methods of public notice

4758-1-01 establishes the procedures for the adoption of rules and methods of providing public notice.

OAC 4758-1-03 Minutes of board meetings

4758-1-03 establishes the procedures for handling the minutes of board meetings.

OAC 4758-5-06 Requirements for certification of registered applicants (RA)

4758-5-06 establishes the requirements for the certification of registered applicants (RA).

OAC 4758-6-03 Scope of practice for licensed chemical dependency counselors II (LCDC II)

4758-6-03 establishes the scope of practice for licensed chemical dependency counselors II (LCDC II).

OAC 4758-6-06 Scope of practice for registered applicants

OAC 4758-13-05 Lapsed license or certification/restoration process

4758-13-05 establishes the process for handling a lapsed license or certification and the restoration of a lapsed license or certification.

OAC 4758-13-06 Expired license or certificate

4758-13-06 establishes that under the following circumstances it is a violation of Chapter 4758 of the Revised Code:

- When a person holds themselves out as a chemical dependency counselor or prevention specialist if their license or certificate has lapsed or expired.
- When a person practices chemical dependency counseling or drug and alcohol prevention while their license or certification is suspended or revoked.
- When a person engages in chemical dependency counseling and do not already hold a valid license or certificate to practice chemical dependency counseling under Chapter 4758 or are exempt from licensure or certification requirements under Chapter 4758.

OAC 4758-20-01 Personal information systems

4758-20-01 establishes regulations that will govern the control of personal information maintained by the Board.

OAC 4758-99-01 Independent rules

4758-99-01 establishes that each rule of rules 4758.01 to 4758.99 of the Administrative Code and every part of each rule is an independent rule and that the holding of any rule or any of its parts unconstitutional, void or

ineffective for any cause shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other rule or any of its parts.

Once the rules are filed, JCARR has 90 days to review the rules. For four consecutive weeks after the rules are filed, JCARR will provide public notice of the Board's no change determination. After the four-week public notice period, the rules will be scheduled for a JCARR hearing.
